Conditions of Block Party/Street Closure

- Stages, Moon Bounces, or Inflatable Jumpers may not be placed in the City Street or Sidewalk.
- Permittee has sole responsibility for the proper placement of traffic control devices as outlined in the Location of Street Closure section above.
- Barricades may not be placed mid-block.
- Permittee shall be responsible for all costs associated with renting barricades.
- Streets will be closed to through traffic only.
- Streets shall remain open to residents at all times.

Long Beach Municipal Codes

- > FIREWORKS ARE ILLEGAL IN THE CITY OF LONG BEACH.
- > ALCOHOL IS NOT PERMITTED on City property or in the street at any time.
- > NO LIVE OR AMPLIFIED MUSIC is allowed on City property or in the street. All equipment must be on private property and may not exceed the Long Beach Municipal Code noise ordinance or disturb the peace.
- > A 20' FIRE LANE MUST BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES. Emergency vehicle access must remain readily available during all hours of occupation of street.
