50 years as an organization and 40 years with historic landmark status, the BPNA's mission is to protect, promote and educate on the character, integrity and value of the Bluff Park Historic District and foster a sense of neighborhood collaboration, unity, civic engagement, and goodwill in the city.

# **Bluff Park Historic Lamppost Project**

Lampposts create charm, nostalgia, a sense of place and time. Ours are uniquely symbolic and featured on our logo and street signs. Most streets no longer have decorative lampposts, although old photos and plans show they once existed or were intended more broadly. The vision of BPNA's *Historic Lamppost Project* is to remove uncharacteristic modern street lights in the Bluff Park Historic District and install historically appropriate lampposts matching the look and pattern of the late-1920s E. 1st Street lampposts. Just 8 years ago a committee formed inspired by historic preservation, uncovered a sketch of the E. 1st Street lights, and reached out to the original manufacturer still in-business today. Now that company is proudly making the *Project*'s lampposts based on the same old specifications.

Tonight, we celebrate the accomplishments, while propelling the momentum. The inaugural phase (Paloma Avenue) was installed in 2019. Phase 2 (Temple Avenue) came to light in 2021. In 2022 having been awarded a prestigious grant from the Long Beach Navy Memorial Heritage Association, the manufacturing has now started just this very week for Phase 3 (Molino Avenue) with next year's installation being planned with Public Works Director Eric Lopez and his team. Each phase so far has consisted of 10 new ornamental lampposts with 80 Donor recognition plaques. Milestones achieved through partnership, community engagement, volunteerism, perseverance, patience, and grassroots fundraising from growing scores of donors and supporters from all over the neighborhood, city and beyond. Our leaders Councilwoman Suzie Price, Councilwoman Cindy Allen, and Mayor Robert Garcia nurtured and fortified the passion with much needed support, including a just announced unprecedented additional allocation in the 2023-27 City of Long Beach Infrastructure Investment Plan. Participating again as a select nonprofit in Long Beach Gives, our fundraising and excitement-building are set for future phases in fulfillment of the entire Historic District. Mentor-matriarch Helena Segelhorst reminds us, "It's doable!" And it is! The *Historic Lamppost Project* helps build camaraderie around a common goal and reconstructs an iconic, enduring historic symbol for all of the city of Long Beach.
